

Medical Biochemical Fellowship Application Checklist

Application Deadline: September 30th

Candidates applying for admission are asked to submit the following:

✓ **Application Form**

Only completed applications with ALL required documentation will be considered.

✓ **Curriculum Vitae**

An outline of your educational and professional experience.

✓ **Personal Statement**

An essay to provide additional evidence of your intellectual interests and creative achievement.

✓ **Medical School Transcript and Diploma ***

For reviewing purposes, electronic copies of your medical school transcript and diploma may be submitted to meet the application requirements.

✓ **Residency/Fellowship Training Diploma***

An unofficial copy of your residency/fellowship training certificate of completion is required for review. If your training is still in progress, please see below for instructions on how to proceed.

Director's Verification Letter*

Program Director's verification letter will be accepted for those anticipating completion of a genetics residency training program or equivalent. A copy should be uploaded to your application for evaluation.

✓ **Letters of recommendation**

At least three letters of recommendation are required and one should be from your Genetics Program Director.

The online application system will require you to submit your recommender's names and email addresses. The system will then send an automated email to each of your references with a secure link to the online system, allowing them to submit letters on your behalf.

(*) NOTE: Official transcripts and notarized copies of each diploma will be required ONLY if you are offered admission to the program and sent directly to the Department of Molecular and Human Genetics at the address list below.
