

Translational Research Institute for Space Health (TRISH) Cost Sharing Requirement

Each RECIPIENT institution is required to cost share at a level of no less than 10% of the total award.

Please note the following points about cost sharing, referenced from 2 CFR 200.306 – Cost Sharing or Matching:

- Cost sharing may be contributed in cash or in-kind (non-cash contributions) provided by non-Federal third parties.
- Items that are considered part of facilities and administrative costs are not to be recorded as cost sharing (i.e. compensation to administrative personnel).
- Cost sharing contributions must meet the following criteria:
 - Verifiable from the recipient's records,
 - Not included as contributions for any other Federal award,
 - Necessary and reasonable for the project,
 - Allowable under 2 CFR 200, Subpart E – Cost Principles,
 - Provided for in the approved budget when required by the awarding agency, and
 - Have not been paid by the federal government under another award.
- Cost Sharing examples:
 - Salaries & benefits.
 - Value of additional % effort contributed by PI.
 - Equipment purchases.
 - Supplies.
 - Travel.
 - Tuition fees.
 - Indirect costs.
 - Value of volunteer services towards the project.
