<p>About TRISH</p>	<p>TRISH is at the forefront of space health technology. Partnered with NASA via a cooperative agreement, TRISH provides funding for very early stage as well as late stage research that can quickly be adapted for use in space. TRISH has a high risk threshold and is solving space health issues as defined by NASA's Human Research Program. It is not required that you fully understand NASA's risks. If you are performing terrestrial human health and performance research, your work may be adapted for use in space. Mentor registers as PI and the trainee registers as the postdoctoral fellow. 3. Create proposal. 4. Authorized organizational representative from the mentor's institution submits the proposal.
